Senior Civil Judge	Original jurisdiction (It derives delegation of power from District Court to decide appeals which are transferred)	From Rs.10,00,001/- to Rs.50,00,000/- in Telangana Courts
Small Causes Court	Original jurisdiction	<u>From Rs.4,001/- to Rs.10,000/-</u>
Junior Civil Judge	Original jurisdiction	Upto Rs.10,00,000/- in Telangana Courts
Small Causes Court	-do-	<u>Upto Rs.4,000/-</u>

NOTE:-

1. Upto Rs.4,000/- Small Cause Suit jurisdiction is given to the Junior Civil Judge and from Rs.4,001/- to Rs.10,000/- to the Senior Civil Judge Court to take-up the cases.
2. Small Causes Court has no jurisdiction to try suits for specific performance of a contract, partition of immovable property, foreclosure or redemption of mortgage etc.,
3. Court of Subordinate Judge derives delegation of power from District Court to decide Appeals which are transferred to its file.
